**Service of Remembrance** A Service of Remembrance Prayer Service will be held on Monday, Nov. 2, at 6:30 pm. Mary Mother of the Church will call to mind the souls of our departed loved ones, especially those parishioners who have had their funerals with us in the previous 12 months. All are welcome. This year we will **not** be inviting pictures in memory of loved ones as we have in past years.

**Book of Remembrance** In the month of November – beginning with the Feasts of All Saints (Nov 1) and All Souls (Nov 2) – the Family of God remembers the souls of our departed loved ones. MMOC records the names of parishioners who have died in the previous 12 months in our Book of Remembrance. Everyone is invited to pray for them and to write the names of their own loved ones whose funerals have been in other places, especially those who have died in the last year. The Book of Remembrance will be in a place of honor near the Easter Paschal Candle for the majority of the month of Nov.

**Anointing of the Sick** Please join us on Tuesday, Oct. 27 for 10:30 AM Mass (instead of the 7:30 AM Mass). This Mass will include Anointing of the Sick for those who would like to be anointed. Those with the following health conditions should consider receiving the sacrament:

- A heart condition
- A serious ailment or disease
- The elderly who are notably weakened by age
- Imminent surgery due to illness or injury
- An emotional affliction

By the grace of this sacrament, God strengthens both body and soul to face the extra anxiety and temptations that come with sickness.

**Ministry of Greeter** This ministry was created to meet diocesan regulations for safe, orderly movement in/out of church and for sanitizing the church after every Mass. This ministry is open to middle school students and older who are willing to...

- arrive 30+ minutes before Mass
- wear mask and gloves during active ministry times (supplied by parish)
- select among 3 kinds of Greeter options: Welcome (at doors), Worship Aid (distribution), and Seating
- remain after Mass to sanitize pews/chairs, door handles, bathrooms, etc.

We need many more volunteers so we can lengthen the schedule rotation. Training sessions will be held **Oct. 26 at 6:00 pm (Mon)**, **Oct. 29 (Thurs) at 3:00 pm**, and **Oct. 29 at 6:00 pm (Thurs)**. No registration needed.

**SCRIP** When you buy scrip a percentage of your purchase is given back as a rebate. Aquinas Catholic Schools and Religious Education families use this rebate to help offset the cost of tuition. There is a large group of parishioners who donate their rebates to the Building Fund. There is also the option to buy scrip and donate your rebate back to the parish which helps cover the cost of running the scrip Program (e.g. shipping, copy paper, and supplies). Scrip is a great way to support the parish!

**Scrip Drive Up Day** At the next curbside scrip sale and food drive on Friday, Oct. 30, you will be invited to bring cleaning supplies to be donated to The Exchange. The Exchange is an organization that collects furniture, household items, and just about any practical thing you would need to set up an apartment. Items they never get are cleaning supplies, Dollar Store brooms, dustpans, mops, buckets, toilet bowl cleaner, brushes, mops, dish-washing liquid, etc. These are items they have to purchase. Let's make a difference to those not as blessed as ourselves by helping them to start anew.

### WeShare News

Currently, Mary, Mother of the Church Parish has **190 parishioners** using WeShare for their **recurring contributions** to the parish: regular monthly support (i.e. Financial Commitment), special collections (e.g. Mission Sunday), and/or pledging to Building Our Future Together. In addition, there are another **117 parishioners** who use WeShare on a **“one-time”** or **“occasional”** contribution basis. WeShare Online Giving is a safe, convenient and efficient way to convert your parish support offerings from the traditional “check in an envelope” to an electronic draw through your bank or credit card.

It is **safe**. WeShare is a feature of Liturgical Publications, an organization that serves Catholic Parishes throughout the United States. Your personal information is safely encrypted. No information is shared or sold to any other organization. Only you can change or modify the information on a WeShare account.

It is **convenient**. Once you set up your WeShare account you need not worry that you've missed a contribution or left your envelope on the kitchen table when heading out for Mass. Each time a transaction is due to occur you receive an email from WeShare advising of the contribution scheduled to happen within the next few days. If at that time you want to change or delay the contribution, you may go on line to WeShare and change or cancel that particular contribution.

It is **efficient**. Online Giving saves you extra steps when contributing and makes the accounting in the parish office much easier when recording contributions. Transactions are safe and secure between your bank and the parish's bank account. The parish office receives an electronic transaction summary that is downloaded in a timely manner to individual contribution reports for a high rate of accuracy.
